day 1

Arrive Yerevan, Armenia

Arrive Yerevan and private car transfer to hotel. Check in hotel as per time. Rest of the day free to explore the city. Overnight a Yerevan hotel.

Musaler is a village in the Armavir Province of Armenia. The town was renamed in 1972 after Musa Ler, the site of Armenian resistance in 1915. Sardarapat Memorial Museum was built in 1978, in the place of heroic battle of Sardarapat in May of 1918; due to Armenian soldiers' bitter struggle the brilliant victory was won. Yerevan – Tbilisi, Georgia - Boat Tour in Tbilisi

Breakfast at hotel. Private car transfer to Yerevan airport to board the flight to Tbilisi by Flyone Armenia at 0930 hrs. Arrive Tbilisi at 1015 hrs. Private car transfer to hotel. Evening join the Boat tour in Tbilisi. Duration 35 mins. Metekhi Cathedral (Pass By). We will pass right under Metekhi Cathedral - one of the oldest churches in Tbilisi and will be able to see it from unique angle. The Bridge of Peace (Pass By). We will pass right under the Bridge of Peace - the iconic glass bridge, not to be missed while in Tbilisi and will be able to see it from unique angle. Tbilisi Public Service Hall (Pass By). We will pass by the iconic mushroom-like building made of glass and will be able to see it from unique angle. Anchiskhati Basilica (Pass By) We will pass by the oldest surviving church in Tbilisi, dating back to sixth century. Baratashvili Bridge (Pass By), then pass under the Soviet-style bridge, named after a Georgian poet, who is the greatest representative of the Georgian Romanticism. The bridge is famously dubbed as the 'Bridge of Love', visitors will pass under the romantic bronze figures overlooking from the bridge. Presidential Palace (Pass By). We will pass by the Former Avlabari Residence of the President of Georgia overlooking from a hill. Overnight at Tbilisi hotel.

Day Tour Tbilisi – Ananuri – Kazbegi – Tbilisi

The Gergeti Trinity Church was built in the 14th century by an unknown architect, and is the only cross-cupola church in Khevi province. The separate bell tower dates from the same period as the church itself, but built somewhat later. Its isolated location on top of a steep mountain surrounded by the vastness of nature has made it a symbol for Georgia. The 18th century Georgian author Vakhushti Batonishvili wrote that in times of danger, precious relics from Mtskheta, including Saint Nino's Cross were brought here for safekeeping. During the Soviet era, all religious services were prohibited, but the church remained a popular tourist destination. The church is now an active establishment of the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church. Evening return to hotel. Overnight at Tbilisi hotel.

Also, there are many other unique monuments exist in Old City (Icheri Sheher): mosques, minarets, remnants of caravanserais such as "Multani" and "Bukhara", ancient baths etc. A lot of shops with souvenirs, where you can buy traditional clothing, scarves and hats, pottery and handmade carpets. Walk down the street of Nizami (old Shopping street with lots of souvenirs shops), fountain square, visit the shopping center "Park Bulvar" and other boutiques. The Boulevard is the second largest in Europe, where tourists can take a boat trip along the Baku.. Return to hotel. Afternoon free a leisure. Overnight at Baku hotel.
